**A few reminders**

Remember: the speed limit in our neighborhood is 25 MPH. Keep our kids safe and watch your speed!

Please follow the CC&Rs with regards to proper storage of boats and RVs. Boats, Trailers, RVs (and regular vehicles) are not permitted to be parked on the street or in driveways for more than 48 hours. If you will be having extended visitors with trailers or RVs, contact the board to explain your special circumstances and request a temporary exception to the stated covenants and restrictions.

Pets should be leashed or tethered (under strict control) at all times. Homeowners who feel threatened by aggressive behavior from any animal are encouraged to notify the Black Diamond Police Dept., King County Animal Control and the board (in that order). Please pick up after dogs when you are walking them in the neighborhood. Also, dog owners should take steps to know how your animal is behaving when you are not at home. Constantly barking dogs is the number one complaint to the board during the spring and summer months. Please be considerate of your neighbors, we have a number of homeowners who work from home. It is a source of distraction and irritation to listen to a dog barking all day long.

All exterior paint projects and most additions, major renovations (exterior), fences, tree removal, on-site RV storage, etc...Require HOA Board approval. Please check CC&Rs which are posted on our website or contact the board via email for clarification on restrictions, approval and the process for obtaining such.

Rob from Maple Valley Lawn and Landscape has offered to make a good deal to Morgan Creek Homeowners who would like their lawns aerated. Please contact the board if you are interested in this service and we will pass your name and phone number on to him!

Invoices for unpaid dues are in the process of being done up and will be mailed out in the first part of June. For those who chose to pay in two halves, there are no interest or service fees applied to the second half billing. If no dues have been paid to date for the 2008 calendar year, your HOA account is considered past due and interest and fees will be applied to your billing as per CC&R compliance.

**As we approach the summer holiday times, specifically 4<sup>th</sup> of July, the board would like to encourage everyone to have a Safe and Sane Summer. Adhere to all city and county restrictions regarding fireworks and noise. Know where your children are at all hours and remind them that pranks involving damage to personal property are A) illegal and B) not so funny for others.**
